Purpose of the group:

Wellbeing Warriors promote good wellbeing among pupils throughout the school. The group is mentored by a member of staff.

The Wellbeing Warriors team agree to:

- ✓ Ensure that all pupils are able to share their thoughts and concerns and that these are shared with the wellbeing team
- ✓ Ensure that they are known by the whole school community so pupils are able to discuss concerns and issues with them

One pupil from each class from Year 1 to Year 6 form the Wellbeing Warriors group.	Elected during Pupil Voice group election fortnight	Wellbeing Warriors staff lead All staff to ensure the election fortnight takes place
Meetings are held fortnightly and minutes/actions are recorded in the minutes document saved on Google Drive.	Fortnightly	Wellbeing Warriors staff lead
Ground rules are established at the start of each meeting.	Fortnightly	Wellbeing Warriors staff lead
Wellbeing Warriors report back to their class after each meeting.	Fortnightly	Class teachers to ensure a brief pupil voice group feedback session takes place in their class each week
Wellbeing Warriors to lead a campus assembly every term around the work they have been doing	Termly	Wellbeing Warriors staff lead & Wellbeing Warriors
Review any worries posted in the Worry Box within their class.	Fortnightly - just before the Wellbeing Warrior meeting.	Class teachers, Wellbeing Warriors & Wellbeing Warriors staff lead
Wellbeing Warriors record concerns/ questions raised in their classes (or from the Worry Box) in their Wellbeing Warrior book and take to the Wellbeing Warrior meeting for discussion - keeping all information anonymous.	Fortnightly	Class teachers, Wellbeing Warriors & Wellbeing Warriors staff lead
